PORTFOLIO SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Photographically speaking, your portfolio is you. It represents to others exactly what you wish them to know about you as a photographer - showing your aesthetic, creativity and craftsmanship. Therefore, the portfolio you submit for jurying will be considered as representing your best work.

To assist you in putting together the best portfolio for our review, we would like to provide the following guidelines:

- The portfolio should consist of 12–15 matted, unframed prints, cohesive in content and style, with the dimension of the portfolio no larger than 16”x 20”.
- Include up to 10 additional images showing the scope and range of your work. These may be printed and unmatted or on a CD.
- The prints you submit should represent the quality of work you would be showing and selling in the gallery. Always show your best work.
- Black-and-white images printed using traditional darkroom processes must be printed using fiber-based materials and archival processing.
- Digital prints must indicate the inkset and paper used and the estimated life expectancy of the print. If you are using non-archival materials, the life expectancy must be stated.
- In the case of color portfolios, images not printed by you must have been done under your direct supervision and the printer acknowledged.
- The portfolio should be submitted in a case that is easy to store and handle, with a maximum size of 18”x24”.
- Clearly identify your portfolio and each print.



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We strongly recommend a paperback book by John Kaplan, *Photo Portfolio Success, A Guide to Submitting and Selling Your Photographs*, published by Writer's Digest Books as an excellent reference. If you have further questions, please contact us at the gallery.

By following these guidelines, you will make your very best impression and help us to fairly evaluate your work.
